Who are you?

Uitsig is an Animal Rescue Centre, situated on 40 hectares of agricultural land on the outskirts of Cape Town.

What do you do?

“Rescue, Rehabilitate & Re-home” offering a safe haven to those in need.

Where do the animals come from?

They have come into the Centre from local townships and surrounds or they have been surrendered by families who are no longer able or willing to keep them.

How big are you?

We are one of the largest rescue organizations in the Western Cape who have approximately 500 dogs, 70 cats, 10 horses and other animals in our care.

What is the core ethos of the Centre?

We provide a refuge for the ‘throw-away’ pet and rescue animals living in untenable conditions.

What we do...

Rescue, Re-habilitate & Re-home, Abandoned, Abused, Neglected & Stray Animals

Our core functions include:

- **Boarding** of dogs for other Rescue organizations that have no space or premises
- Mass **Sterilizations** and animal care education in surrounding townships
- Educate rather than Confiscate: fetch, **heal and return** injured and sick animals to their ‘township’ owners.
- Take ‘old, unwanted’ dogs where they can live out their years with dignity rather than euthanize.
- Provide non-judgmental **animal care** to impoverished residents of surrounding townships.

We don't...

- Euthanize - We're PRO-LIFE.
- Re-home animals without strict home checks, vaccinations, sterilization & owner vetting.
- Compromise on our animal care.

What we have...

A dedicated, fearless, passionate founder and leader, Denay Saunders



500+ dogs housed in ‘camps’ (8-10 suitably matched animals in fenced off areas cobbled together with donated and second-hand materials and kennels.

15 Staff members who build ‘camps’, feed, dip, care for and monitor all the animals on the farm.

20-40 regular volunteers who interact with, socialize, groom and exercise the dogs and other animals.
