

Rules & Regulations

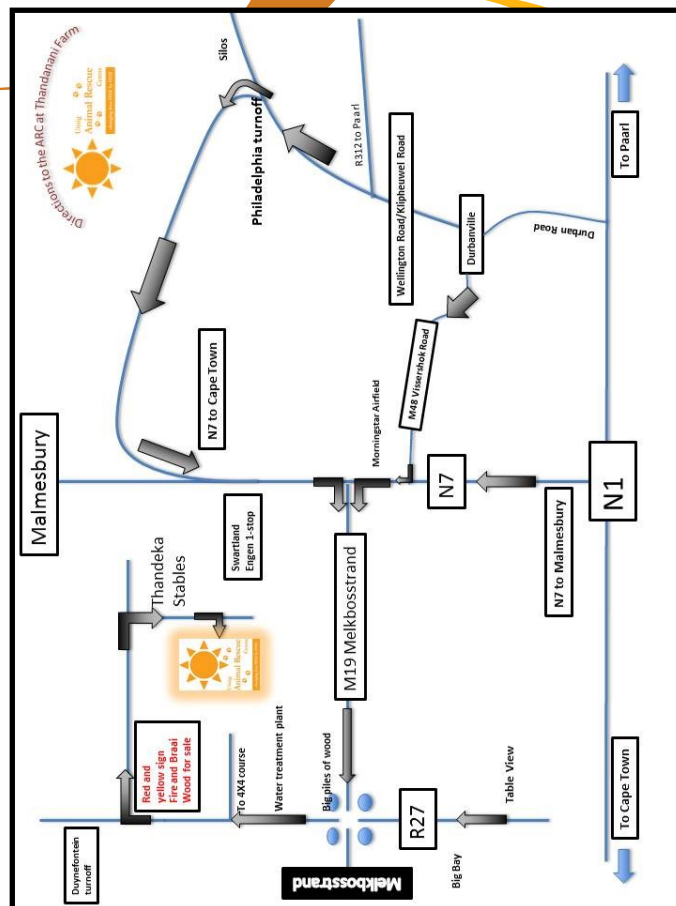
THESE RULES HAVE BEEN PUT IN PLACE FOR THE SAFETY OF THE DOGS AND VISITORS ALIKE AND TO ENSURE AN ENJOYABLE EXPERIENCE FOR ALL.

- All visitors must report to Reception on arrival
- NO running, shouting / screaming
- NO taking out or putting dogs back into enclosures WITHOUT a coordinator present
- NO entering of camps and gates marked with relevant signage, WITHOUT a coordinator present
- NO touching of puppies
- PLEASE hand all leads back when you leave, as this is the property of the Uitsig dogs
- All the huskies walk and run in harnesses, with the exception of one or two, which will be pointed out by the coordinator of the group on the day
- Walkers use the same trail. It is non-negotiable that you rein in your dog on a short lead when passing other dogs
- Please do not approach the other dog camps while walking a dog, or try to stay as far away as possible from the fence if the walking route takes you nearby
- You must spray your hands and bottom of shoes before entering a cattery

If you would like to join in walking and running our huskies you are most welcome. We get together every Saturday morning and we cover various distances based on the dogs' ages and fitness levels. Please bring along a reliable, strong lead. Children are welcome to join in the walks, but due to the nature of the breed we cannot allow young children to walk the huskies themselves. Children must be accompanied by a parent/legal guardian at all times. Older teens under 18 with the physical strength to handle a very powerful dog may do so.

After the walk we spend time with them in their camps, grooming them and loving them and giving them that all-important human interaction that they need and love. They don't just like to go walking, but adore to cuddle and play afterwards. Please do stay for a little while to spend some quality time with them!

We meet very early in the morning in the parking lot (times vary depending on the season) and then walk down to the husky camps.

We have senior dog handlers which walk our dogs on Saturdays between 9am and 2pm, the times might change due to the heat in the summer. At the moment our dogs are still very unsettled in their new environment, so only the senior coordinators are allowed to enter the general doggie population. However, additional handlers are allowed to walk specific doggies on a Saturday morning. STRICTLY NO children under the age of 15 will be allowed to walk dogs on their own— even if accompanied by an adult.

We will team you up with a senior handler that will assist you. If you are able to commit to helping on a regular basis, even one Saturday a month you are able to work yourself up to senior handler status which will then enable you access to the general doggie population in future. At the moment we are unable to accommodate large groups for doggie walking and can only take approximately 5 additional interactive visitors per Saturday.
